

Dear Mr. Andrews,

The Board of Blaine County Commissioners recently affirmed its intent to contribute \$14,500 cash and \$200 in-kind service to the Blaine Soil Conservation District (BCSD) budget for fiscal year 2015, contingent upon final appropriation during the County's budget process. The Board understands that BCSD shall use such funds during State fiscal year 2015 (July 1, 2014- June 30, 2015). The Board is pleased that, with the County's contribution, BCSD is eligible to receive matching support from the State of Idaho, not to exceed twice the county allocation, contingent upon adequate Legislative appropriation.

The Blaine Soil Conservation District is expected to present its work plan and highlight the use of funds at a public hearing during the County's budgeting process. At this time, it is our understanding that you intend to designate \$4000.00 for BCSD's office rent and the balance, among other things, to carry out the active conservation programs outlined in your work plan. Blaine County also will conduct an election for the Blaine Soil Conservation District as a service valued at \$200.00 and designated by the State of Idaho as in-kind service.
