The Owyhee Conservation District receives money from Owyhee County. Each year the district supervisors and administrative assistant bring a scrap book of the previous year's accomplishments. The Owyhee commissioners budget funding is tight, yet this year they increased our stipend from \$2500 to \$3000. The conservation district mission is to preserve agriculture, protect soil, water and air on our working lands. We do this through educating the farmer and the public in newest trends and sciences that are proven to help. Farmers and ranchers are busy tending their crops; district supervisors as elected officials goal is to keep agriculture healthy and the control local and voluntary. The district applies for a noxious weed grant yearly to control the spread of noxious weeds. This program is utilized by Owyhee County residence and assists the county weed program by allowing them to concentrate on county areas. Over the last few years we have applied for grants to help with the many programs we have. This year a small award of \$329 was received from US Ecology an Owyhee County based corporation. That money is tagged for a projector to use at our pesticide class, weed management safety class and annual banquet. As small as our office is we accomplish whatever we can for our residents.
