Dear Tim:

The Valley County Commissioners, barring unforeseen circumstances, intend to provide the Valley Soil and Water Conservation District a total of \$29,899 during fiscal year 2014. Of this \$29,899, \$6,500 will be a direct cash payment; \$16,511 will be allocated for the cost of furnishing office space; and \$6,888 will be allocated for all utilities including janitorial services and snow removal. The Valley Soil and Water Conservation District should make a request for the direct cash funds prior to Sept 30, 2014.

Such funds are to be used by the District to carry out an active conservation program as outlined in the annual plan supplied to us. It is also our understanding that the State of Idaho is authorized to match the County funds provided to the Valley Soil and Water Conservation District to not exceed twice the County allocation.
