

Dolly the Idaho Dairy Cow

- The Jefferson SWCD recently purchased a life size fiberglass cow that is taken around to all the schools in the county. District employees and board members teach eager listeners about how we eat the things cows provide, cows eat plants and plants eat dirt. Naturally following this life cycle style discussion students learn about how important it is to care for our soil and water so that we can continue to have hamburgers and milkshakes for dinner. Lastly students are given the opportunity to milk Dolly and are taught the proper way to do so. This year we have been to 25 classes reaching over 750 students with more classes scheduled for the spring.
