

Mission Statement

The mission of the Camas Conservation District (CCD) is to set high standards for conservation of the natural resources in the district; to encourage cooperation among landowners, government agencies, private organizations, and elected officials; and to ensure an adequate natural resource base for present and future generations.

Recent Activities

- CCD co-hosted and participated in the District 26 **Legislative Luncheon**.
- **Information displays** were placed at the State Capitol, Camas County Fair, Senior Center and Library.
- Two **tree sales** have been done this year.
- Five **well depth measurements** on 30 wells were taken during this fiscal year; three in 2014 and two in 2015.
- We participated in the NRCS **snow survey** during the winter of 2014-2015, doing measurements at two sites.
- We hosted our third **Arbor Day Open House**, partnering with NRCS and the City of Fairfield. 250 seedlings were handed out as well as many tree-related brochures.
- We participated in **NACD's Poster Contest** –"Pollinators-Your Hardworking Heroes". We awarded tee shirts with the pollinator logo on them to all nine contestants.
- Two children were **sponsored** to attend **Natural Resources Camp** in Ketchum.
- **2 senior scholarships** were awarded.

- **Sponsorships to Southern Idaho Biological Control Program, Envirothon, LSEE, Idaho Forestry Contest and AITC** were distributed.
- A teacher was sponsored to attend one of **AITC's workshops**.
- A partnership continued with NRCS, Camas County and the City of Fairfield to **provide a shelterbelt** at our local medical facility. Ground has been prepared, mainline irrigation lines have been installed and CCD has dedicated funding for a portion of the project. Several private donations for the project have also been collected.

Ongoing Activities

- Camas County **Planning and Zoning** depends on the CCD for environmental suggestions and advice when development and subdivisions are proposed. Two reviews were done this year.
- Working with NRCS, EQIP and CSP contract payments have been made on existing contracts and new applications for contracts have been submitted.
- Again, working with NRCS and Water District 37B, measuring device structures are being installed, as per required.

Future Projects

- We are planning a spring 2016 completion date for the Medical Center Shelterbelt Project. Lateral distribution lines and mulching materials need to be installed and trees and shrubs need to be planted.
- We are planning our fourth Arbor Day Open House and want to include children's activities this year.
- We will continue to be available to assist Camas County in the development of the Manmade area.


