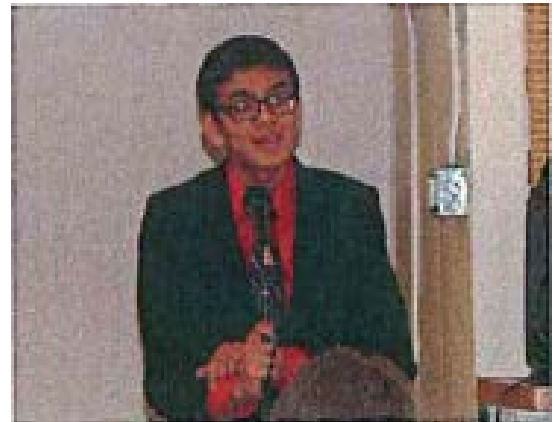
FY 2018 Accomplishments

- Assisted Mountain Home Irrigation District with an engineering evaluation for the repair of a tunnel below Little Camas Reservoir.
- The Orchard Project was completed. 160 acres were sprayed for Bur Buttercup, seeding was completed, and fence was installed.
- Sponsored 4 students at the Natural Resources Camp. Students made a presentation of their experiences to District supervisors.
- Five students from Mountain Home High School competed in the Annual Speech Contest. Oam Patel won not only the District and Division levels, he also placed first at the IASCD State Conference. Congratualtions to Oam.

Future Plans and Projects

- Locate funding to repair Mountain Home Irrigation District's damaged tunnel.
- Continue the rehabilitation of the Ditto Creek Fire are. This is a project in partnership with landowner Mr. Damele, USFWS, and the BLM.
- In partnership with Mr. Helmick (landowner) and the USFWS, extend a pipeline from a spring to extend grazing management improvements.
- Continue to assist Elmore County with mosquito and weed abatement programs.
- Partner with Elmore County on a ground water recharge project.
- Partner with the Atlanta Fire District to develop fire suppression, dip pond, and erosion control.
