Technical Assistance Request — FY 2021 Twin Falls SWCD

The Twin Falls SWCD would like to request 32 hours of technical assistance from ISWCC during fiscal year 2021. This time will be used to help collect soil samples for the long term soil health testing program, manage samples, track data collected throughout the project, work with cooperators participating in the project and share information with cooperators who are interested in soil health. Twin Falls has three cooperators participating in this project.

Over the course of this five-year project, soil samples are collected from the same field at roughly the same time of year. Samples are analyzed for biological activity during the first, third and fifth years; while conventional samples are collected during the second and fourth years. University of Idaho and the USDA NRCS are project leaders and ISWCC staff will coordinate with those individuals.
