Utilization of State Base and Match Funds Report

Funding from the State of Idaho base and match was used for payroll, audit expense, rent expense, and public outreach within the local community to encourage continued conservation within the district. Public outreach included staff time to organize and implement "hands on" district sponsored opprotunties such as Natural Resoruce Awareness Day, 5th Grade Annual Field Tour, IASCD Speech and Poster Contest, Bread in a Bag, Ag Week and work with the locall FFA and Agriculture shop. This included a field tour with approximately 30 high school students to visit project sites. Custer SWCD leveraged district funds to write the required documents to allow continued funding through the Northwest Power Planning Council and the Independent Scientific Review Committee to retain Bonniville Power Fundng. Funds were allocated to the High Country RC&D for grant writing assistance. The District also used district staff time to prepare and administer Pacific Coast Salmon Recovery Funds for Loon Creek, which is outside the BPA funding. Custer SWCD conitues to work with Custer County on a Wetland Mitigation project involving a State Highway grant with Custer County Road and Bridge as well as seek funding to assist the county with road and bridge grants. We have also provided administrative help to the county when requested.

Personnel costs represent approximately 40% of the budget, 20% for operating and 40% District conservation projects including youth education and public outreach.
