➤ This 5-year project has several objectives: Evaluate the health of the soils in our area by testing their chemical, physical, and biological properties. Assess the effects of various agricultural practices on soil health, such as planting cover crops, using no-till or reduced tillage, integration of livestock, using manure or compost in addition to or in place of commercial fertilizer, and other practices. Educate producers about the importance of soil health. Track our progress in improving the health of our soil over a 5-year period.
