2022 Progress Report


This year WQPA Funds were made available for grants through the Commission. We jumped into the application process early and with the help of NRCS and Commission employees were able to secure grants for 2 landowners in the first round of funding. These were landowners that had previously been unsuccessful applying for funding through NRCS. The projects enabled the landowners to make the move from flood irrigation to pivot. These should be a great water saving projects.


The Board is currently working on applications to obtain a no-till drill. They see the benefits of cover crops, grazing, and also the decrease of erosion from excessive tillage. They would like to lease it to landowners who would like to implement new practices into their operations. There are a number of grants that address these issues and we hope to obtain one next year.

They have also seen some interest in Virtual Fencing projects. This allows the landowner to apply confined grazing plans and protect sensitive landscapes such as riparian areas.

The EPA has designated an area in North Bingham County as having an elevated Nitrate level. We are working with the Commission, DEQ, and NRCS to make funds available for grants to implement BMP's in the area. We will also be putting together an Outreach Education program to go along with the grants, encouraging land and home owners to test their water so the levels can be monitored.
