#### **2022 District Accomplishments**

- Annual Soil Health Symposium: Due to continuing risks to gather for large events during the COVID-19 pandemic, plans for a 12<sup>th</sup> Annual Soil Health Symposium were cancelled for 2022, but organization for a 2023 symposium began in 2022 with an event committee.
- Lower Payette River, Mid-Snake Hells Canyon, and Little Willow Creek TMDLs: Two State Ag 319 grant projects, that replaced surface irrigated ag lands with center pivots, were completed in 2022. The district facilitated a tour of these completed projects with IDEQ and other interested community members. A Federal 319 grant was awarded to the district by IDEQ and project implementation is to begin in Fall 2022. With continued assistance from ISWCC staff, the district applied twice for an Idaho Water Resources Board Aging Infrastructure grant on behalf of one of the Payette County drainage districts. The Chairman voiced district concerns in a USEPA virtual public hearing regarding the first proposed oil and gas waste water injection well in Payette County.
- Outreach and Education: The district worked at revising its website <a href="www.payetteswcd.org">www.payetteswcd.org</a>
  District supervisors attended and provided input to USDA NRCS in a virtual Local Working Group meeting to identify local natural resource priorities for the federal agency. The district provided an educational display at the Payette County Fair in August. District supervisors updated their board on Payette County Planning & Zoning issues as related to local agriculture and natural resources. Community members were invited and attended the district projects tour.
- **District Operations:** The district maintained an independent, viable district office to provide efficient and effective service to the public. Supervisors attended IASCD Division III meetings, a Soil Health Conference in Burley, ID, reviewed and approved their 5-Year Plan, and completed required district reports. The district appointed a new supervisor and is engaged in recruiting another.
