Central Bingham held it's annual Tree Sale in April. The money that is earned from the sale is used throughout the year to help with Youth Education and Outreach throughout the District.

The district received a grant from DEQ, helping multiple landowners/producers with removal of Russian Olive trees that are invading on their pasture, farms, and rangeland. The grant also assisted in paying for a fence to keep wild horses coming into farmland from the river in Springfield. We have since secured another grant to continue the Russian Olive Removal Projects. We feel very fortunate to have participated in these Conservation Projects.

With the opportunity of WQPA money available this year we received 2 grants to improve water quality and irrigation efficiency. Both projects helped put a pivot's on land that was previously flood irrigated. One followed an earlier grant project that put pipe in a ditch feeding a pump that was losing as much as 40% of the water along the way. Both landowners are seeing great improvement in their pasture growth. We thank both the Commission and NRCS for their help in securing the grants, and are looking forward to future projects.
