## Recent Projects

### 319: Lower Salmon

#### Goals:

The project sites are located on private lands within the Lower Salmon watershed in the tributaries of Maloney Creek and Deep Creek. The sites are primarily livestock feeding areas for winter feeding of cattle. The vegetation in the creeks is primarily hawthorn and service berry where shrubs are present. The hill sides are dominated by yellow star thistle, with benches being planted to grasses. Deep Creek and the Lower Salmon River are listed for nutrients, temperature, bacteria and sediments. This project addresses these pollutants directly by working with the private landowners to improve feeding areas, forest health, and range health. Deep Creek needs an 84% reductions in E. Coli, and a 13% reductions in sediment. The plan specifically proposes access road, heavy use area protection, forest stand improvement, watering facilities, spring developments, and stream crossings.

#### Actions/Results:

In FY23 landowners began implementation on their projects. They installed off site watering facilities that removed access to the creek and remove one from the creek completely.
