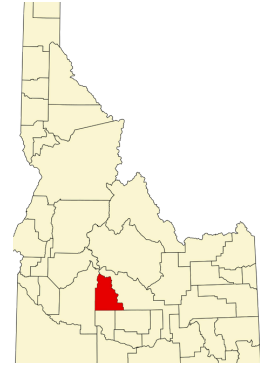

## PROJECTS/ACTIVITIES

### \*TWIN LAKES CANAL PROJECT

The Camas Prairie Twin Lakes project enhanced two sections of an aged and deteriorated canal and repaired the elevated flume where the Twin Lakes canal flows over the top of Soldier Creek. The WQPA grant proposal was approved for \$123,750 in state funds for the project and benefits five local producers.

The Irrigation Company provided \$37,500 in cost-share funds. The Water savings from the improvements are estimated to be roughly 178 acre feet over the 45-day irrigation season.

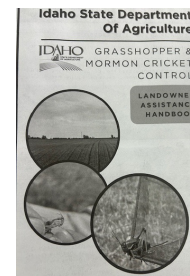
