North Side Pump Co. WQPA

The North Side SWCD sponsored a State Water Quality Program for Agriculture (WQPA) project with the North Side Pump Co. to replace unlined laterals and pumps installed in the 1920s.

The District used its own dollars to provide additional funding for bank stabilization at the canal company's Red Bridge regulating reservoir.

North Side SWCD provides a tree seedling to every third grader in Jerome County. That was over 700 trees in 2025.

Future Projects Irrigation Efficiency

North Side SWCD is working with Soiltech, a local company, to develop an irrigation efficiency project. Soiltech manufactures probes that can monitor parameters such as soil moisture, humidity and temperature to help cooperators better schedule irrigation applications. The program will likely involve cost-sharing with growers who utilize groundwater to offset the purchase cost of the sensors. As demand for water increases across southern Idaho, irrigators must become more efficient.
