The CREP, in Idaho, is a state and Federal partnership to conserve groundwater in the area of the Easter Snake Plain Aquifer.

Program enrollments last for 10 years, with a one-time Federal signup incentive payment, annual Federal rental payments, up to an 13% State match of the annual Federal rental payment, and cost share of up to 50% to establish permanent vegetative cover on the enrolled acreage.

Enrollment in CREP is available in part or all of the counties listed in the adjacent table at up to the rates listed.

CREP is a groundwater conservation program. Water Rights associated with land enrolled in CREP are held for the period of the contract. The land is planted in an conservation cover for erosion control and the benefit of wildlife.
