The Bruneau River Soil Conservation District was organized in 1953 and identified their priorities as drainage investigations, developing and irrigating new land for agriculture and performing soil surveys and water table studies. The district’s long-range resource conservation program places high priority on irrigation water management, rangeland management, animal waste management and protection of wildlife habitat.

5. Public Outreach


Location

The Bruneau River District is located in portions of Owyhee and Elmore counties in the southwest corner of Idaho. The Snake River forms the north border. The Bruneau River and the Owyhee River and their tributaries flow through the District.

FY 2019 Accomplishments

- In partnership with Eastern Owyhee CWMA, treated 11,392 acres to control noxious weeds.
- Partnered with private landowners and IDEQ to implement Nutrient Management BMP’s on 8,000 acres

- Staffed the Quagga Mussel check stations at Bruneau and Marsing with the inspection of 6,971 watercraft.
- Partnered with the USFWS and private landowners to implement Hydrilla control measures in the Bruneau River.
- Sponsored a Poster Contest on the topic of noxious weeds. Winning posters were published in a calendar.

- Continue to administer watercraft inspections stations in Bruneau and Marsing.
- Educate ranchers on rangeland and riparian Best Management Practices
- Continue to provide leadership in controlling invasive terrestrial and aquatic weed species.


